Materials: 200 yards worsted wgt yarn, markers, #9 - 24" circular needles
Homework: Cast on 136 sts and connect without twisting.

Knit 7 rows of K2 P2

1:00 - 2:30

Scarf Necklace B. Hildreth \$5.

Materials: @ 80 yards of Bonsai, Cotton Twist or a decorative yarn. Optional - 132 6.0 beads, #9 dp needles

This is a fun piece using I-cord. The long decorative rope is a great accent on any sweater.
